Hi Parents,



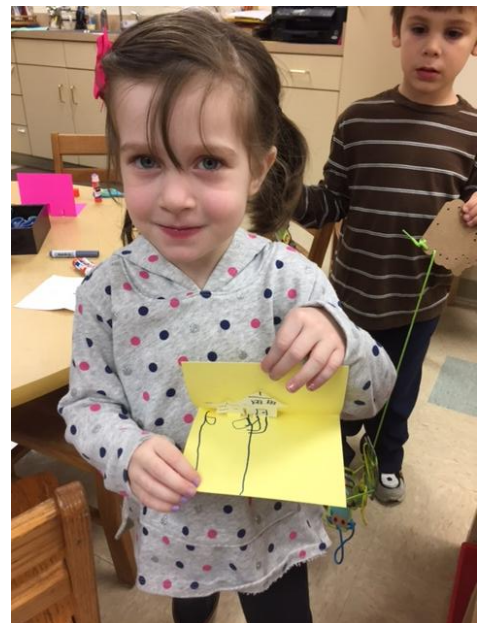
Our book project is in full swing! The children have been making pop-up books, lift-the-flap books and touch books. This week, they may also make a "how-to" book. In *The Studio*, Kelli Domke has been concentrating on book illustrations by using examples by various authors (i.e. Cynthia Rylant and Eric Carle) and helping the children to be illustrators by trying new art techniques. They have cut shapes out of black paper, used torn tissue paper and glue, and created splatter paintings!

In the classroom, you can see these activities:

- Practicing being good listeners at circle time by sitting criss-cross applesauce with our hands on our legs, our eyes on the teacher and our voice off
- Learning about sequencing at the math table
- Making beautiful music with the instruments in dramatic play
- Recognizing the numerals 1-6 as we play a math game
- Sharing the items in our share jar at snack time
- Reading terrific books in the book center.
